## **Nomination of candidates to the Electoral College for the term 2024-03-01 – 2027-02-28**

### ***Background***

The Electoral College shall fulfil the requirements of Chapter 2 Section 8 of the HEO on the University Board's obligation to consult teaching staff, other staff and students in the process of appointing a vice-chancellor or deputy vice-chancellor.

The representatives of teaching staff with research expertise and of other staff on the Electoral College also appoint teaching staff representatives to the University Board through elections and are responsible for any by-elections.

The Electoral College has 48 members of which 24 are teaching staff with research or artistic expertise and 12 represent other staff. The students appoint 12 members.

The Faculty of Social Sciences is to elect **three teachers with research expertise and one representative for other staff** for the term 2024-03-01 – 2027-02-28.

### ***Nomination process***

#### Who can nominate to the Electoral College?

Employees at Lund University holding a continuous position, or a short-term position with a minimum duration of two years, and with an employment of at least 50% of full-time, are entitled to vote and nominate to the Electoral College.

In addition to the above criteria, the employees eligible to nominate and vote for candidates from the Faculty of Social Sciences, are employees of the faculty. Holders of doctoral studentships are not entitled to vote or nominate as they are regarded as students in this context.

#### Who can be nominated?

In order to be eligible for the position of representative of teaching staff with research expertise, the candidate must be a professor or member of the teaching staff at the Faculty of Social Sciences, holding a position requiring a PhD or equivalent. Members of staff at the faculty that are not teaching staff with research expertise are eligible for election in the category other staff.

**The Nominating committee invites those eligible, to provide nominations in order to fill these four positions at the Electoral College no later than 15 January 2024.**

**Please note before sending your nomination:**

- The person you nominate must first be consulted and confirm his/her/their availability for the position. Include this information in your email.
- Nominating oneself is permitted.
- Do specify to which category the candidate is nominated (i.e., teachers with research expertise, or other staff).
- Nominations are to be sent to [valberedning@sam.lu.se](mailto:valberedning@sam.lu.se) **no later than 15 January 2024 marked “Nomination UK”.**
