Code of Conduct for First and Second-cycle Students

The Faculty of Social Sciences aims to offer all students a high-quality education and a good study environment. Each student's relationship to their studies, fellow students, teaching staff and other faculty staff is of great importance if they are to benefit from the knowledge and experience gained. The Code of Conduct, intended to be used as a basis for discussion and reflection, clarifies some of the expectations on students at the Faculty of Social Sciences to facilitate their studies and their time spent with us.

All students at the Faculty of Social Sciences are expected to act in accordance with Lund University's core values and as follows:

- respect everyone's equal value, democratic principles, and human rights and freedoms.
- respect the rights and opportunities of all members of staff and students regardless of background, sex, transgender identity or expression, ethnicity, religion or other belief, disability, sexual orientation or age.
- treat fellow students, teaching practitioners and other members of staff with respect.
- contribute to a positive and inclusive study and work environment. This includes a study environment free from harassment, sexual harassment and discrimination.
- behave in accordance with the principle of academic integrity, which includes not cheating, misleading, or plagiarising and instead openly and clearly acknowledging sources.
