

Lending conditions for borrowing a computer at the Faculty of Social Sciences

- Only students at the Faculty of Social Sciences may borrow a computer, and only for use in teaching that requires a computer.
- The loan is registered in LUBcat. To borrow a computer, a library account and an LU card are therefore required.
- Borrowed computers must be treated with care.
- Only the person who borrows the computer can collect it. The computer is not handed over to anyone other than the borrower, even on presentation of a power of attorney.
- The computer must not be handed over to anyone else.
- If the borrower discovers damage to the computer, the damage must be immediately reported to staff at Sambib.
- When the Faculty of Social Sciences' library reclaims a borrowed computer, after the loan period has expired, the borrower is obliged to immediately return the borrowed computer.
- If the borrowed computer is damaged or not returned, the borrower is obliged to pay the cost of the borrowed computer. Repairs of the borrowed computer must not be taken care of by the borrower themselves. If the borrower violates this, then they are obliged to compensate as if the borrowed equipment had been lost. The Faculty of Social Sciences nevertheless retains the damaged equipment as its property.
- If the compensation amount, determined according to the previous point, has not been paid within the prescribed time, the Faculty of Social Sciences will demand the amount or submit the case to debt collection.

The following is included in the loan:

- Computer
- Computer bag
- Charging cable
