The Faculty is to elect its Faculty Board for the term 2018-01-01 – 2020-12-31. The Board members comprise the dean, the pro-dean, six members of teaching staff with research or artistic expertise, two members other staff and two external members.

Entitled to vote and nominate are employees of Lund University who are employed at the Faculty of Social Sciences until further notice or for a continuous period of at least two years and whose employment is equal to at least 50 per cent of full-time. Holders of doctoral studentships are not entitled to vote or nominate as they are regarded as students in this context in accordance with Chapter 1 Section 4 of the HEO.

The nominee must have been asked and accepted the nomination. Nominating oneself is permitted. Nominations are to be sent to valberedning@sam.lu.se no later than 28th of April 2017.
